

Cash/Valuables in Transit Drivers are responsible for operating to the highest security standards and performing all elements of the Cash In Transit service.

The role could include the safe custody of cash from bank deposits and change funds to ATM cash replenishments and coin delivery.

On occasion, you may be asked to help cover other areas such as the Vault or Control Room and may also be asked to undertake various duties in the depot.

You will also be responsible for route planning, compliance of procedures and also the care of your vehicle, and you must drive in a safe manner and in accordance with the Road Traffic Act and Highway Code.
