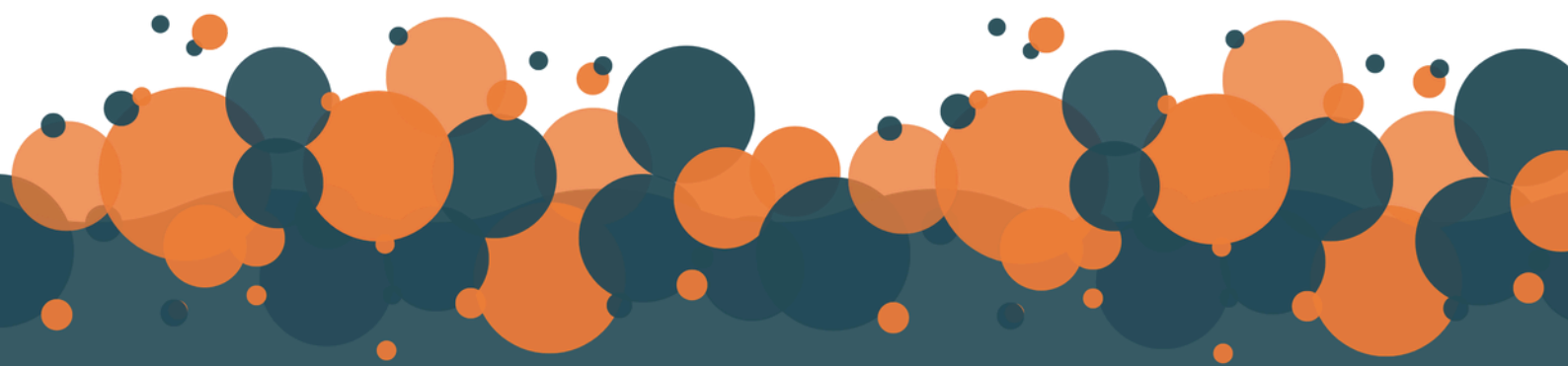

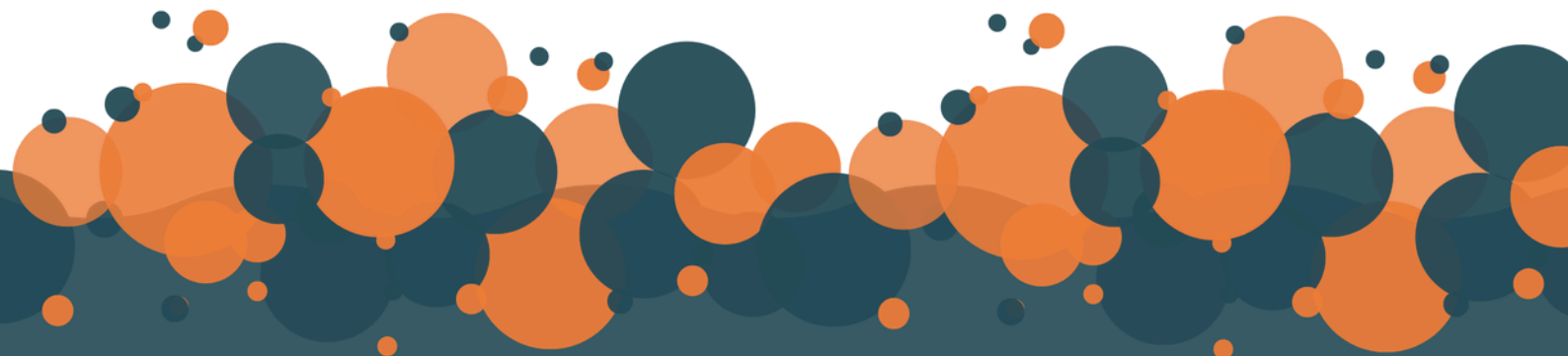

In 2025, our in-person convention welcomed delegates from central and local government, employers, third sector organisations, and skills and employment support providers.



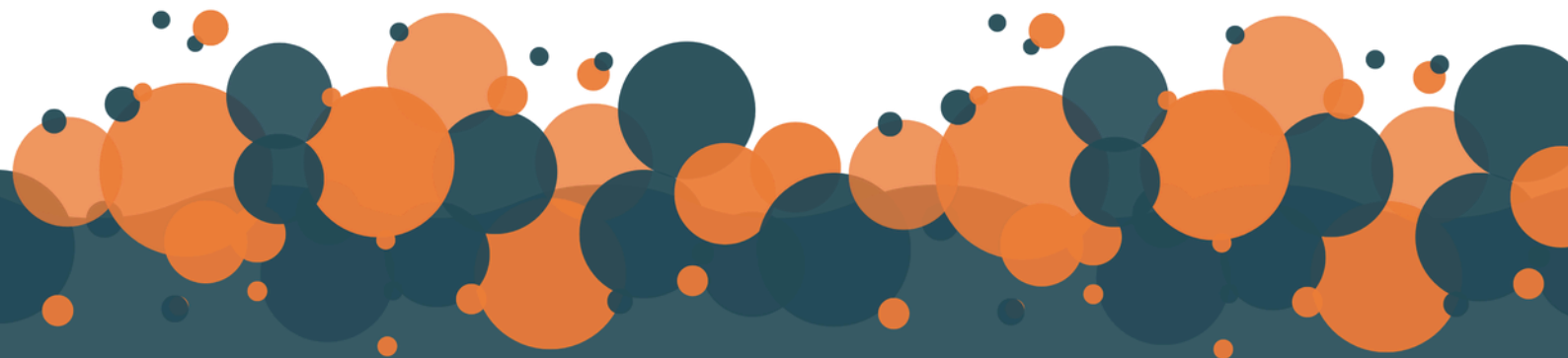

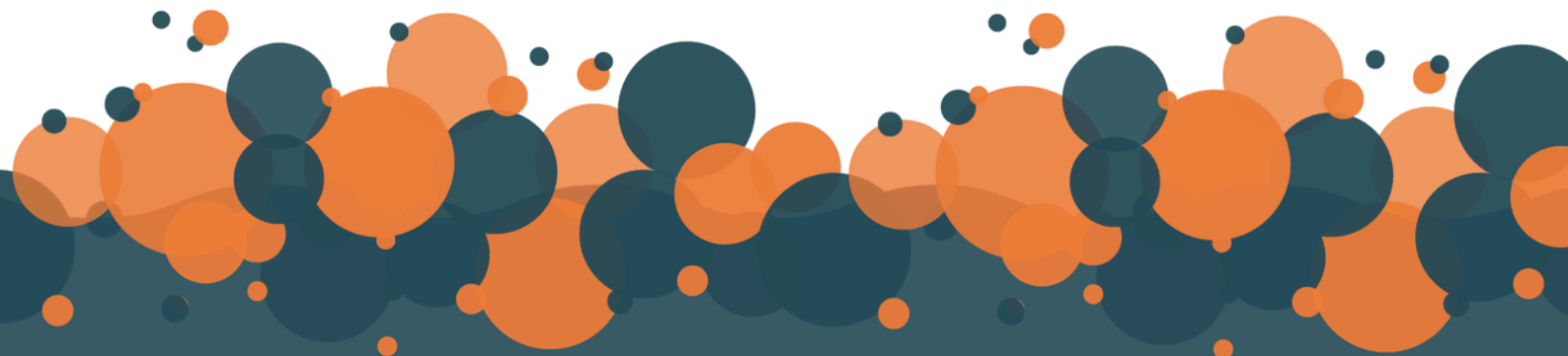

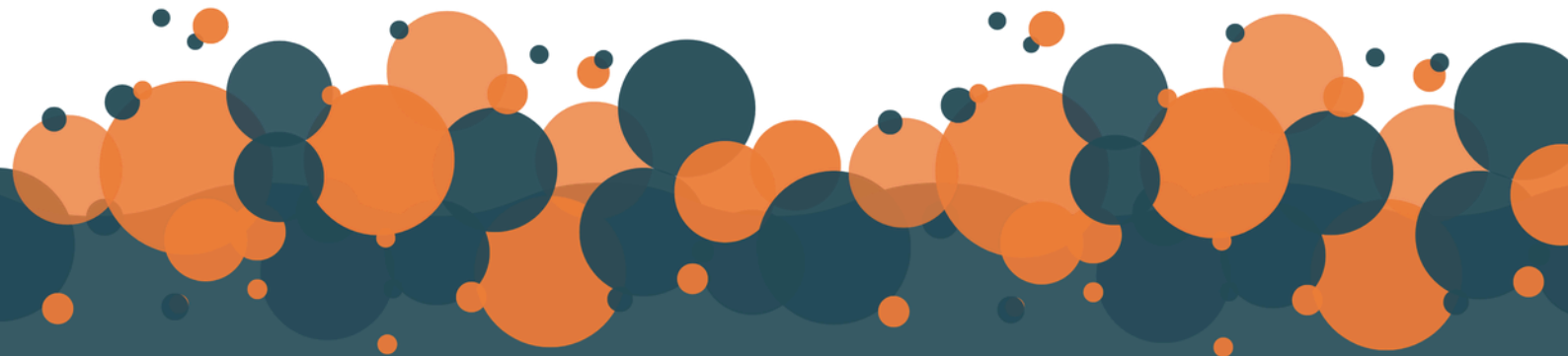
