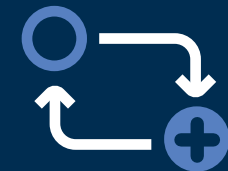
27 sector-based videos produced

What has worked well?

- **Long-standing, trust-based partner relationships** enabled effective collaboration, shared ownership and problem-solving.
- **A clear, shared mission** on employability and workforce retention aligned priorities.
- **Embedding local labour market information** and realistic pathways made the offer relevant.
- **Co-creation** led to more accessible and engaging content.
- **Extensive testing and iterative design** simplified language and tailored content to users.
- **Employer involvement** grounded content in local workplaces and increased credibility.
- **Strong partnerships with referral organisations** supported early engagement with target learners.
